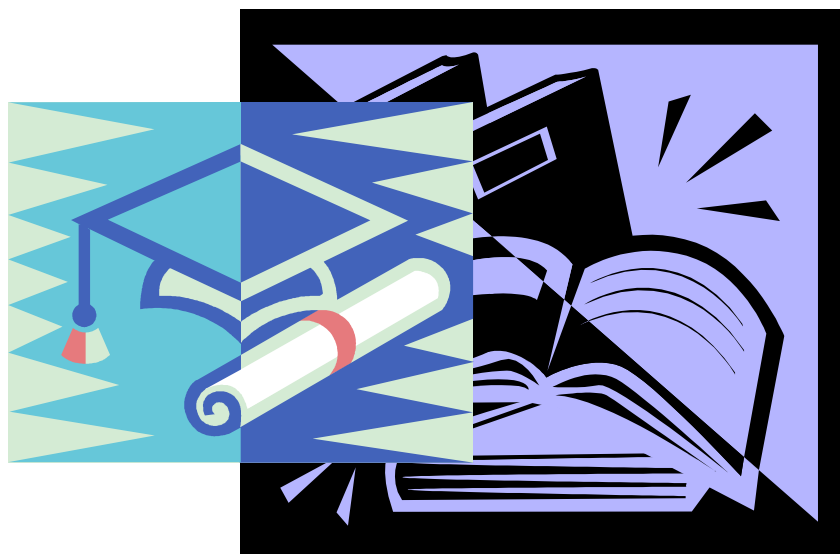

NSYSU Admission for International Students

1. Eligibility

Eligibility is stated in Article 2 of the “MOE Regulations Regarding International Students Undertaking Studies in Taiwan.” Applicants should refer to the full text of the regulation provided by MOE in case of inquiries.

- (1) Individuals of foreign nationality, who has never held nationality status from the Republic of China and does not possess an overseas Chinese student status at the time of application, are qualified to apply for admission under this regulation.
- (2) Individuals of foreign nationality, pursuant to the following regulations and who held residency overseas continuously for no less than 6 years, are also qualified to apply for admission under this regulation.
 - a. An individual who has a nationality status from the Republic of China at the time of birth but does not hold a household registration must state this status on the application.
 - b. An individual who has had nationality status from the Republic of China but has renounced this nationality status with formal annulment notice from the Ministry of the Interior for at least 8 years at the time of the application.
 - c. Regarding individuals mentioned in both of the above articles must not have studied in Taiwan under the status of Overseas Compatriots nor have received admission to academic programs by the University Entrance Committee for Overseas Chinese Students.
- (3) According to the Education Cooperation Framework Agreement, a foreign national, who was selected by a foreign government, organization, or educational institution and does not hold a R.O.C. household registration from the time of their birth is not subject to the limitations as prescribed in Paragraph 2, are eligible to apply with approval from Ministry of Education.
- (4) An individual, who had both foreign and R.O.C. nationalities and had renounced this nationality status with formal annulment notice from the Ministry of the Interior for at least 8 years before Feb. 1st, 2011 (the effective date of the MOE regulation), is then qualified to apply for admission as an international student and is not subject to the limitation of holding continuous overseas residency for no less than 6 years (as prescribed in Paragraph 2).
- (5) An individual who did not register as an international student and completed high school education in Taiwan, with exception of individuals who had graduated from international high schools or from high schools with dual language programs approved by the MOE.
- (6) An individual who has never been dismissed other universities in Taiwan due to poor moral conduct, poor academic performance, or found guilty of committing crimes.
- (7) An individual who does not hold permanent residency of Hong Kong or Macua, or the nationality of People’s Republic of China (P.R.C.).

Violation of any of the above-mentioned criteria will result in immediate cancellation of the applicant’s admission or the deprivation of the applicant’s recognized status as NSYSU registered student, or revocation of applicant’s NSYSU diploma. No certificates will be awarded.

Notes:

- i. According to Article 2 of the “Nationality Law” of R.O.C., a person shall have the nationality of the Republic of China under any of the conditions provided by the following subparagraphs:
 - (1) His/Her father or mother was a national of the Republic of China when he/she was born.
 - (2) He/She was born after the death of his/her father or mother, and his/her father or mother was a national of the Republic of China at the time of death.
 - (3) He/She was born in the territory of the Republic of China, and his/her parents cannot be ascertained or both were stateless people.
 - (4) He/She has undergone the nationalization process.Preceding subparagraph 1 and subparagraph 2 shall also apply to the persons who were minors at the time of the revision and promulgation of this Act.
- ii. The "Overseas Compatriots" prescribed in Paragraph 2 is limited to countries or regions other than Mainland China, Hong Kong and Macau; the term "continuously" means that an individual may stay in Taiwan for no more than a total of 120 days per calendar year.
- iii. The calculation of the 6 and 8 year period prescribed in Paragraph 2 can only be counted up to the starting date of the semester, August 1st of 2012.

2. Admission Application

Required Documents:

- (1) Checklist: a checklist will be generated automatically upon completion of the on-line application form.
- (2) The “Statutory Declaration form” and “Statement of Declaration on Foreign Academic Background”: both forms will be generated automatically after completing the online application form.
- (3) A photocopy of Certificate of Nationality: i.e. passport, residence certificate or birth certificate.
- (4) Certificate of Highest-Level Diploma and Original Transcript:
 - a. Two photocopies of certificate of highest-level diploma earned
 - Must be authenticated by the R.O.C. embassy, consulate office, or Taipei Economic & Culture Office in the country which the applicant resides. The transcript must be sealed by the issuing institute.
 - For undergraduate programs, please provide high school diploma; for graduate programs, please provide Bachelor Degree Diploma; for doctorate programs, please provide Master’s Degree Diploma.
 - Once admitted, applicants should provide verification of certifications upon registration.
 - b. Two photocopies of translated certificate of diploma if the original is not in Chinese or English
 - Must be authenticated by institutes which the applicant has graduated from and by the R.O.C. embassy, consulate office, or Taipei Economic & Culture Office in the country which the applicant reside.
 - c. Two official transcripts
 - Must be authenticated by the institutes which students have graduated from and by the R.O.C. embassy, consulate office, or Taipei Economic & Culture Office in the country which applicants reside. The transcripts must also be sealed by the issuing institutes.
 - Applicants for Ph.D. program should provide both undergraduate and graduate transcripts.

Note: All transcripts must indicate Class Ranking.
 - d. Two photocopies of translated transcripts, if original is not in Chinese or English
 - Must be authenticated by the institutes which applicants have graduated from and by the R.O.C. embassy, consulate office, or Taipei Economic & Culture Office in the country which applicants reside.
- (5) One financial statement issued by a bank in the country which the applicant resides should be sent directly from the bank office to the mailing address below.
 - a. Scholarship recipients MUST provide a photocopy of scholarship certificate; if scholarship stipend is below NT\$15,000 per month, please submit a financial statement of at least NT\$100,000 (USD\$3,300).
 - b. Applicants without any scholarship must provide a financial statement of at least NT\$ 300,000 (USD\$ 10,000).
 - c. If the financial statement is not in the name of the applicant, a declaration with signature from the sponsor must be included, stating the relationship with the applicant and guaranteeing responsibility for all of applicant’s expenses in Taiwan.
- (6) Certificate of Nationality Renouncement of Republic of China (if applicable):

Required for applicants who once held nationality of Republic of China. Applicants must have renounced their nationality for at least 8 years from the date of the certificate to the first day of the semester, August 1st, 2012.
- (7) Other materials required by specific Undergraduate/Graduate Programs (if applicable).

Please refer to attached “Application Requirements for Undergraduate/Graduate Programs”.
- (8) Other documents stated in NSYSU Financial Aid application (if applicable).

Notes :

- * **Once admitted, foreign diplomas and transcripts must be verified by a Taiwan Overseas Mission in the country of the institution. If there is no Taiwan Overseas Mission in the country, please inquire a nearby Taiwan Overseas Missions. Two original documents and two original verified translations are required.**

3. How to Apply

Application form can ONLY be completed online and printed. Please visit <http://oiasys.oia.nsysu.edu.tw/>.

Please complete application procedure online, print and sign the following forms: (1) application form, (2) statutory declaration form, and (3) statement of declaration. Return the signed forms along with the required documents by either mail or in person to the Office of International Affairs at Room 2001 of the Administration Building by March 31st, 2012.

The application package must be delivered in person or posted by express courier service (recommended for remote areas) to the following address by March 31st, 2012. **Applications received after the deadline will not be processed.**

4. Key Dates for Entry

- (1) Feb 1st ~ March 31st, 2012: submission period for application package(s).
- (2) May 31st, 2012: admission announcement posted on NSYSU website.

5. Chinese Language Proficiency

Applicants who are unable to maintain good standing in course work due to language difficulties will be encouraged to take Chinese language courses at his/her own expense at the Chinese Language Center, NSYSU. Admission status can be postponed for a maximum of one year. For more information, please contact the Chinese Language Center at +886-7-525-2000 ext. 3031.

Notes :

- * Please note that most of the undergraduate courses are instructed in Chinese. Applicants should have sufficient listening, speaking, reading and writing ability in the Chinese language.

6. Visa

- (1) Applicants must submit an original copy of the medical examination report (including HIV Antibody Test) to a nearby R.O.C. embassy, consulate office, or Taipei Economic & Culture Office along with visa application.
- (2) Applicants with any question regarding visa should contact the Bureau of Consular Affairs under the Ministry of Foreign Affairs (website: <http://www.boca.gov.tw>; Tel: +886-2-2343-2888; Fax: +886-2-2343-2968).

7. Financial Aids

- (1) Applicants may apply for "NSYSU Financial Aid" when applying for admission. For more details, please visit the NSYSU on-line application website.
- (2) Scholarships are offered by various organizations. The Ministry of Education offers the Taiwan Scholarship (website: <http://english.moe.gov.tw>), and the International Cooperation and Development Fund (ICEF) offers the Higher Education Scholarship Program (website: <http://www.icdf.org.tw/mp.asp?mp=2>).
- (3) Applicants must note the different application deadlines for scholarships offered by different organizations. Please note that the admission and scholarship application procedures are separated, except for scholarship offered by NSYSU. Applicants who are scholarship recipients are NOT guaranteed admission to the university, and applicants who are admitted to the university are NOT guaranteed any scholarship.
- (4) Applicants can only choose to receive ONE financial aid at a time.

8. Part-Time Job Opportunities

After studying in an academic program for two semesters or a language program for one year in Taiwan with excellent academic performance, international students are eligible to apply for work permit for both on- and off-campus jobs. International students may work up to 16 hours per week, with the exception of summer and winter vacations. Foreigners working in Taiwan are required to file an income tax in May each year. Details concerning foreigners working in Taiwan are specified in the "Regulations on the Permission and Administration of the Employment of Foreign Workers" on the Council of Labor Affairs' website at

9. Registration

- (1) Academic year: August 1st ~ July 31st.
 Fall semester: Mid-September ~ Mid-January.
 Spring semester: Mid-February ~ Mid-June.
- (2) All admitted students should complete registration accordingly. Failure to complete registration procedure is regarded as forfeiting admitted status.
- (3) Documents required at registration:
 - a. Highest degree diploma, verified with official stamps by the R.O.C. embassies, consulate offices, missions abroad or by other notary institutes authorized by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, R.O.C. (This document will be returned). If the diploma is not in Chinese or English, a notarized photocopy of a translation in English or Chinese is required; a degree diploma from a Taiwanese university does not require further verification.
 - b. Newly admitted international students are required to submit proof of insurance, which includes both medical and accidental coverage for a period from September of 2012 to March of 2013). The proof of insurance is required to be authenticated by the R.O.C. embassy, consulate office, or Taipei Economic & Culture Office in the country where the student resides. Returning international students are required to submit proof of National Health Insurance (NHI).

Note:

* Should the submitted documents be found forged, fraudulent or altered, etc., students' admitted status will cancelled or students' registered status will be revoked; no degree certificate will given.

Remarks:

- i. "Full-time continuing student" refers to the student who is in 5th year of Bachelors or 3rd year of Masters and Ph.Ds.

- ii. All full-time continuing students with 9 credits or less are charged credit and miscellaneous fees; if more than 10 credits, will be charged as full tuition fees.
 - iii. Master and Ph.D. students who have completed all courses are required to register and are charged miscellaneous fees.
- c. Students admitted to NSYSU via Education Cooperation Framework Agreement (such as Taiwan Scholarship, VEST500 and other similar programs) shall pay for tuition fees in accordance with the agreements.
- (2) Insurance fee: it is mandatory for international students living in Taiwan to join the National Health Insurance (NHI) after acquiring the ARC (Alien Resident Certificate) for 6 months and the insurance fee will be included in the tuition fees payment form. Students are required to provide proof of personal health insurance upon registration prior to joining the NHI for the period from September of 2012~March of 2013.
 - (3) Dormitory fee: NSYSU provides on-campus housing. Dormitory fee is approximately NT\$27,500 per academic year (not including summer and winter breaks). Students may submit application forms for housing after being admitted. Rooms are assigned on a first-come-first-served basis.
 - (4) Miscellaneous fees: Expenses on textbooks vary depending on the fields of study. Fees for meals are approximately NT\$7,000 to NT\$9,000 per month.

11. Notes

- (1) Application period for the 2012 Fall Academic Semester for international students begins on February 1st, 2012. Required documents and related regulations are specified in the “MOE Regulations Regarding International Students Undertaking Studies in Taiwan” on MOE website, (http://www.edu.tw/content.aspx?site_content_sn=23092) for further information.
- (2) Each applicant may apply for at most two undergraduate/graduate programs, and at most one group within one undergraduate/graduate program; when applying to two undergraduate/graduate programs, please submit an application package for each program and indicate your preference on the application form.
- (3) Applicants may choose only one program to study once admitted.
- (4) Applications received after the deadline will not be accepted and not be considered for admission.
- (5) The admission process of international students is stipulated by the “MOE Regulations Regarding International Students Undertaking Studies in Taiwan” (Note: for more information, please visit the Ministry of Education website: <http://english.moe.gov.tw/>).
- (6) Once official admission announcement has been made, admitted international students will receive “Letter of Acceptance” and are required to reply a “Declaration of Intent to Study at NSYSU” by email or post **BEFORE June 30th, 2012**; conditionally accepted students are required to submit supplementary documents by the previously mentioned deadline. Applicants who have not confirmed by deadline will be regarded as to forfeit their admitted status.
