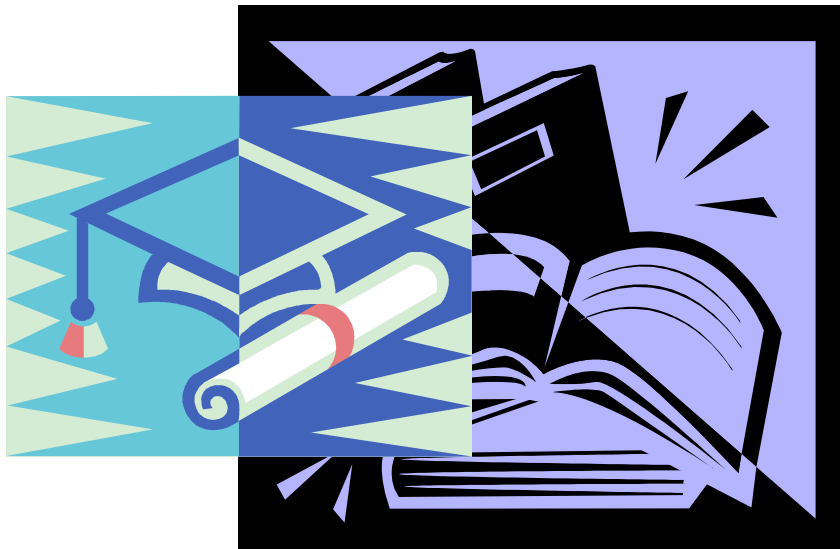

# NSYSU Fall 2014 Admission for International Students

2013.11.19

## 1. Eligibility

Applicants' eligibility is based on "MOE Regulations Regarding International Students Undertaking Studies in Taiwan". If the MOE Regulations are updated, these Regulations announced by the MOE will take priority. For updated information relating to the MOE Regulations, please contact the MOE directly.

- (1) Applicants must qualify for legal student status in compliance with Article 2 of the Ministry of Education's Regulations Regarding International Students Undertaking Studies in Taiwan". International students are defined as follows:
  - a. Individuals of foreign nationality, who has never held nationality status from the Republic of China and does not possess an overseas Chinese student status at the time of application, are qualified to apply for admission under this regulation.
  - b. Individuals of foreign nationality, pursuant to the following regulations and who held residency overseas continuously for no less than 6 years, are also qualified to apply for admission under this regulation.
    - i. An individual who has a nationality status from the Republic of China at the time of birth but does not hold a household registration must state this status on the application and statutory declaration form.
    - ii. An individual who has had nationality status from the Republic of China but has renounced this nationality status with formal annulment notice from the Ministry of the Interior for at least 8 years at the time of the application.
    - iii. Regarding individuals mentioned in both of the above articles must not have studied in Taiwan under the status of Overseas Compatriots nor have received admission to academic programs by the University Entrance Committee for Overseas Chinese Students.
  - c. According to the Education Cooperation Framework Agreement, a foreign national, who was selected by a foreign government, organization, or educational institution and does not hold a R.O.C. household registration from the time of his/her birth is not subject to the limitations as prescribed in Paragraph 2, is eligible to apply with approval from Ministry of Education.
  - d. An applicant of foreign nationality, concurrently holding a permanent residence status in Hong Kong or Macao, having no history of a household registration record in Taiwan and, at the time of application, has resided in Hong Kong, Macao, or another foreign country continuously for no less than 6 years.
  - e. An applicant being a former citizen of Mainland China and holds a foreign nationality, having no history of household registration record in Taiwan, and at the time of application, has resided overseas continuously for no less than 6 years. The term "reside overseas continuously" mentioned in the preceding paragraph means an individual may stay in Taiwan for no more than a total of 120 days per calendar year.
- (2) An individual of foreign nationality who did not register as an international student and completed high school education in Taiwan.
- (3) Upon completion of the course of study, at a school in Taiwan, to which an international student has applied, the student's admission to higher academic levels shall be handled in a manner identical to the procedures of admission for local students, except that an application for master's degree or higher level of graduate studies can be processed under the rules of each individual school.
- (4) An individual who has never been dismissed by other universities in Taiwan.
- (5) During the course of study in Taiwan, international students, who have undertaken initial household registration, resident registration, naturalization or restoration of the R.O.C. nationality, will lose their international student status and shall be dismissed by the school.

**Violation of any regulation of MOE Regulations Regarding International Students Undertaking Studies in Taiwan will result in immediate cancellation of the applicant's admission or the deprivation of the applicant's recognized status as NSYSU registered student, or revocation of applicant's NSYSU diploma. No certificates will be awarded.**

Notes:

- i. According to Article 2 of the "Nationality Law" of R.O.C., a person shall have the nationality of the Republic of China under any of the conditions provided by the following subparagraphs:
  - (i) His/Her father or mother was a national of the Republic of China when he/she was born.
  - (ii) He/She was born after the death of his/her father or mother, and his/her father or mother was a national of the Republic of China at the time of death.
  - (iii) He/She was born in the territory of the Republic of China, and his/her parents cannot be ascertained or both were stateless people.

(iv) He/She has undergone the nationalization process.

Preceding subparagraph 1 and subparagraph 2 shall also apply to the persons who were minors at the time of the revision and promulgation of this Act.

- ii. The "Overseas Compatriots" prescribed in Paragraph 2 is limited to countries or regions other than Mainland China, Hong Kong and Macau; the term "continuously" means that an individual may stay in Taiwan for no more than a total of 120 days per calendar year.
- iii. The calculation of the 6 and 8 year period prescribed in Paragraph 2 can only be counted up to the starting date of the semester, August 1<sup>st</sup> 2014.

## 3. How to Apply

- (1) Application form can **ONLY** be completed online and printed. Please visit <http://oiasys.oia.nsysu.edu.tw/>.
- (2) Please complete application procedure online, print and sign the following forms: (1) application form, (2) statutory declaration form, (3) statement of declaration, and (4) Application for NSYSU Financial Aids for Foreign Students (if applicable). These signed should either be mailed or delivered in person to the Office of International Affairs at Room 2001 of the Administration Building by February 28<sup>th</sup>, 2014.  
  
The application package must be delivered in person or posted by express courier service (recommended for remote areas) to the following address by February 28<sup>th</sup>, 2014. **Applications received after the deadline will not be processed.**
- (3) Each applicant may apply for two undergraduate/graduate programs at most, and one group within one undergraduate/graduate program at most; when applying to two undergraduate/graduate programs, please submit an application package for each program and indicate your preference on the application form.
- (4) All documents submitted with the application will not be returned regardless of applicant's admission status. Please keep personal copy for future reference.

## 4. Admission Application

Applicants must **upload and mail** the following documents to the Office of International Affairs at Room 2001 of the Administration Building by February 28<sup>th</sup>, 2014.

- (1) Application Form: the form will be generated automatically after completing the online application form.
- (2) The "Statutory Declaration form" and "Statement of Declaration on Foreign Academic Background": both forms will be generated automatically after completing the online application form.

- (3) Application for NSYSU Scholarship for International Students (if applicable) : the form will be generated automatically after completing the online admission application form.
- (4) Certificate of Nationality Renouncement of Republic of China (if applicable):  
Required for applicants who once held nationality of the Republic of China. Applicants must have renounced their nationality for at least 8 years from the date of the certificate to the first day of the semester, August 1<sup>st</sup>, 2014.

Applicants must **upload** the following documents to the online application system.

- (1) Certificate of Highest-Level Diploma and Transcript:
  - a. One photocopy of certificate of highest-level diploma earned
    - For undergraduate programs, please provide high school diploma; for graduate programs, please provide Bachelor Degree Diploma; for doctorate programs, please provide Master's Degree Diploma.
    - If you are currently studying at an institute, please submit an authorized statement of anticipated graduation issued by the institute.
  - b. One photocopy of translated certificate of diploma if the original is not in Chinese or English
    - Must be issued by institutes which the applicant has graduated from.
  - c. One photocopy of transcript
    - Applicants for Ph.D. program should provide both undergraduate and graduate transcripts.
    - All transcripts must indicate Class Ranking.
  - d. One photocopy of translated transcripts, if the original is not in Chinese or English
    - Must be issued by the institutes which applicants have graduated from.
- (2) One financial statement issued by a bank in the country which the applicant resides.
  - a. Scholarship recipients MUST provide a photocopy of scholarship certificate; if scholarship stipend is below NT\$15,000 per month, please submit a financial statement of at least NT\$100,000 (USD\$3,300).
  - b. Applicants without any scholarship must provide a financial statement of at least NT\$ 300,000 (USD\$ 10,000).
  - c. If the financial statement is not in the name of the applicant, a declaration with signature from the sponsor must be included, stating the relationship with the applicant and guaranteeing responsibility for all of applicant's expenses in Taiwan.
- (3) A photocopy of Certificate of Nationality: i.e. passport, residence certificate or birth certificate.
- (4) Other materials required by specific Undergraduate/Graduate Programs (if applicable). Please refer to attached "Application Requirements for Undergraduate/Graduate Programs".
- (5) Other materials required by NSYSU Scholarship for International Students (if applicable). Please refer to "Items of Documents for NSYSU Scholarship".

## 5. Registration

- (1) All admitted students must submit the following documents before the deadline. NSYSU Acceptance Letter will be mailed to admitted students who have submitted the mentioned documents in time.
  - a. Admission Acceptance Form
  - b. The highest degree diploma and transcript must be authenticated by the R.O.C. Embassy, Consulate Office, or Taipei Economic & Culture Office in the country of the issuing university.  
The translated certificate of diploma and transcripts, if the original is not in Chinese or English. The translated certificate of diploma and transcripts must be authenticated by the R.O.C. Embassy, Consulate Office, or Taipei Economic & Culture Office in the country of the issuing university.
  - c. For applicants who graduated from Taiwanese university, the degree diploma and transcript do not require further verification.

Note: all admitted students must submit the above documents before the deadline. Please be aware that if the documents failed to be delivered before the deadline, the admission will be given to applicants on the waiting list.

- (2) All admitted students must submit the following documents upon registration.
  - a. Original highest degree diploma, verified with official stamps by the R.O.C. Embassies, Consulate Offices, Missions abroad or by other Notary Institutes authorized by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, R.O.C. (These documents will be returned). If the diploma and transcript are not in Chinese or English, a notarized photocopy of a translation in English or Chinese is required; for applicants who graduated from a Taiwanese university, please submit the Chinese degree diploma and it does not require further verification.

- b. All admitted students are required to provide proof of personal health insurance. Please be aware that personal health insurance certificate must be authenticated by the R.O.C. Embassy, Consulate Office, or Taipei Economic & Culture Office in the country which the student resides. Returning international students are required to submit proof of National Health Insurance (NHI).
- (3) Academic year: August 1<sup>st</sup> ~ July 31<sup>st</sup>  
 Fall semester: Mid-September ~ Mid-January  
 Spring semester: Mid-February ~ Mid-June
- (4) All admitted students should complete registration accordingly. Failure to complete registration procedure is regarded as forfeiting admitted status.
- (5) Admitted students who completed five-year high school must take extra credits and subject in accordance with respective department graduation requirements.

**Note:**

**\*If the submitted documents be found forged, fraudulent or altered, etc., students' admitted status will be cancelled or students' registered status will be revoked; no degree certificate will be given.**

**Remarks:**

- i. "Extended study" refers to the student who is in 5<sup>th</sup> year of Bachelors or 3<sup>rd</sup> year of Masters and Ph.Ds.
  - ii. All extended study students with 9 credits or less are charged credit and miscellaneous fees, and will be charged as full tuition fee if more than 10 credits.
  - iii. Master and Ph.D. students who have completed all courses are required to register and are charged miscellaneous fees.
  - iv. The above are estimated tuition rates for the 2014/2015 academic year. The actual tuition fee will be announced on the relevant date.
- c. Students admitted to NSYSU via Education Cooperation Framework Agreement (such as Taiwan Scholarship, VEST500 and other similar programs) shall pay for tuition fees in accordance with the agreements.
- (2) Insurance fee: it is mandatory for international students living in Taiwan to join the National Health Insurance (NHI) after acquiring the ARC (Alien Resident Certificate) for 6 months and the insurance fee will be included in the tuition fees payment form. Students are required to provide proof of personal health insurance upon

registration prior to joining the NHI for the period from September 2014 ~ February 2015.

- (3) Dormitory fee: NSYSU provides on-campus housing. Dormitory fee is approximately NT\$28,600 per academic year (not including summer and winter breaks). Students may submit application forms for housing after being admitted. Rooms are assigned on a first-come-first-served basis.
- (4) Miscellaneous fees: Expenses on textbooks vary depending on the fields of study. Fees for meals are approximately NT\$7,000 to NT\$9,000 per month.

## 7. Chinese Language Proficiency

Application who are unable to maintain good standing in course work due to language difficulties will be encouraged to take Chinese language courses at his/her own expense at the Chinese Language Centre, NSYSU. Admission status can be postponed for a maximum of one year. For more information, please contact the Chinese Language Centre at +886-7-525-2000 ext. 3031.

## 8. Visa

- (1) Applicants with any question regarding visa should contact the Bureau of Consular Affairs under the Ministry of Foreign Affairs (website: <http://www.boca.gov.tw>; Tel: +886-2-2343-2888; Fax: +886-2-2343-2968).

## 9. Financial Aids

- (1) Applicants may apply for “NSYSU Scholarship” when applying for admission. For more details, please visit the website <http://oiasys.oia.nsysu.edu.tw/doc/view/sn/2>.
- (2) Scholarships are offered by various organizations. The Ministry of Education offers the Taiwan Scholarship (website: <http://english.moe.gov.tw>), and the International Cooperation and Development Fund (ICEF) offers the Higher Education Scholarship Program (website: <http://www.icdf.org.tw/mp.asp?mp=2> ).
- (3) Applicants must note the different application deadlines for scholarships offered by different organizations. Please note that the admission and scholarship application procedures are separated, except for scholarship offered by NSYSU. Applicants who are scholarship recipients are NOT guaranteed admission to the university, and applicants who are admitted to the university are NOT guaranteed any scholarship.
- (4) Applicants can only choose to receive ONE scholarship/financial aid at a time.

## 10. Part-Time Job Opportunities

After studying in an academic program or a language program for one year in Taiwan with excellent academic performance, international students are eligible to apply for work permit for both on- and off-campus jobs. International students may work up to 16 hours per week, with the exception of summer and winter vacations. Foreigners working in Taiwan are required to file an income tax in May each year. Details concerning foreigners working in Taiwan are specified in the “Regulations on the Permission and Administration of the Employment of Foreign Workers” on the Council of Labor Affairs’ website at <http://laws.cla.gov.tw/Eng/Default.asp>.

## 11. Notes

- (1) Application period for the 2014 Fall Academic Semester for international students begins on January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2014. Required documents and related regulations are specified in the “MOE Regulations Regarding International Students Undertaking Studies in Taiwan” on MOE website, for further information please visit the websites ([http://www.edu.tw/content.aspx?site\\_content\\_sn=23092](http://www.edu.tw/content.aspx?site_content_sn=23092)) & (<http://oia.nsysu.edu.tw/bin/home.php?Lang=en>).
- (2) Applications received after the deadline will not be accepted and not be considered for admission. Applicants alone are solely responsible if incomplete items delays in admission process. All documents submitted with the application will not be returned regardless of applicant’s admission status. Please keep personal copy for future reference.
- (3) The admission process of international students is stipulated by the “MOE Regulations Regarding International Students Undertaking Studies in Taiwan” (Note: for more information, please visit the Ministry of Education website: <http://english.moe.gov.tw/>).
- (4) Once official admission announcement has been made, admitted international students are required to submit the required documents before the deadline. Applicants who have not confirmed by deadline will be regarded as to forfeit their admitted status, and the admission will be given to applicants on the waiting list.
