Length of paper:

Should be between 5,000 and 7,000 words (not including the list of references) with Times New Roman font, size 12, and single line spacing. The paper must include:

- Title of the submitted abstract
- Name(s) of the author(s)
- Department(s) and affiliation(s)

References:

- Please use in-text citations according to the Harvard Style of referencing
- In-text citations must be enclosed within parentheses and embedded in the paragraph (surname year: page).
- Two authors are cited using ‘&’: (surname1 & surname2). More than two authors are cited using ‘et al.’: (surname1 et al.).
- Footnotes (no endnotes) are used for remarks only.
