

# The Regulation Flowchart of Master Degree

## Course Credit Requirement

A minimum of 36 credits are required for the degree. Per semester, there is a maximum of 15 course credits (which may include credits from other graduate programs in NSYSU) and a minimum of 9 course credits (which must all be within this program). Students can obtain a maximum of 9 credits from other graduate programs as a degree requirement.



## Thesis Supervisor

Students must apply for a Thesis Supervisor no later than the 1<sup>st</sup> semester of the 2<sup>nd</sup> year of enrollment. Students mainly choose full-time professors from this Institute as their Thesis supervisor. Students may choose, to meet the specified field of study, an adjunct professor from this Institute or a professor from another institute with the permission of the Institute Committee Meeting, though they must choose a professor from this Institute for their Thesis defense.



## Other Requirements

Attend at least 10 academic conferences or speeches held by this Institute **one month before degree exam.**

## Registration to the Master Degree Exam

Register for the Degree Exam Applying System on the Office of Academic Affairs website. Registration time: before 30<sup>th</sup> November in the Fall, or before 30<sup>th</sup> April in the Spring.

## Oral Exam for Thesis Plan

**3 months after passing the oral exam for the thesis plan, students can take the degree exam.**



## Master Degree Exam

Students can register for a re-examination in the following semester only one time if they do not pass the degree exam. Students who do not pass the re-examination will not be allowed to continue the program.
